Program Activities:

1.- Training Workshops

Sessions of 90 or 45 minutes, where an expert will thoroughly address a specific topic related to the Central Themes of the Congress. 3.- Round Table

At the end of a series of lectures, there will be a Round Table of 30 to 45 minutes, where the various speakers will answer questions from the audience or those posed among themselves regarding the topic discussed. Simultaneous translation will be available.

4.- Free Communications

There will also be free communications with 10-minute presentations and 5 minutes for questions and comments relevant to the proposed topics, which will be selected by the Scientific Committee.

5.- Electronic posters

Communications in e-poster format will be accepted and must comply with the requirements indicated in the instructions available in the Communications window. The final deadline for submitting these posters is September 15th.

6.- On the evening of Friday the there will be an Official Congress Dinner , by registration, which will take place at the Croatian Stadium, located at Av. Vitacura 8049, at 8:30 pm. The registration fee is \$ 50. 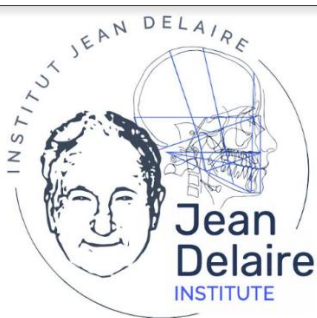
